### Call to Conference

As students navigate complex academic pathways, tutors play a vital role as guides and connectors. This year’s theme highlights how tutoring professionals help students move forward with confidence, connection, and purpose. Join us for the fifth annual 4C Virtual Tutor Conference, *Roads and Bridges: Tutors as Guide* for an opportunity to meet with colleagues across the country as a community of practice, to learn from each other, share ideas, network, and explore the process of helping students. The conference is tutor led, meaning that all sessions are *by* and *for* tutors. For simplicity, the conference materials will refer to tutors, but writing consultants, SI Leaders, PAL facilitators, academic coaches, and other learning support practitioners are also welcome.

Please also consider submitting a proposal to present a concurrent session at the conference. Proposal details are found in the Call for Proposals included in this packet. Supervisors may attend the conference alongside their tutors but do not present.

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### Call for Proposals

Your tutoring practice is a reflection of your pursuit of excellence in academics, career and technical education, pedagogy, methodology, skill application, and much more. This is an opportunity for you to share your experiences, expertise, research, and skills with colleagues across the country. Hone your presentation skills, build your résumé, and gain experience presenting in a national forum. All sessions are *by* and *for* tutors. Tutors may [register](#) and attend the conference without presenting, so long as at least one proposal is received from their institution, and supervisors are welcome to attend alongside their tutors.

#### Presentation parameters

- Each participating institution must submit at least one presentation proposal; Multiple proposals from an institution are welcome.
- Presentations are to be 50 minutes long, including 5-10 minutes for Q&A and wrap-up.
- The presentation must be interactive. No more than 20 minutes of the presentation is to be lecture-style information dissemination.
- All presenters must have a minimum of one semester of tutoring experience.
- CRLA certification is not required to be a presenter, but will be noted in the conference materials.
- A presentation may be co-presented by up to four individuals.
- Proposals are to be vetted and submitted by local tutoring program leadership.
- Consider how your topic connects to the conference theme and make the connection explicit in your proposal.
- The electronic **proposal submission deadline is September 18, 2026**. A printable submission planner is included with this packet. You can download a fillable PDF version at the [Tutors page](#) of the 4C website.

- CRLA training topics
- mentoring newer tutors
- building connections with campus departments and organizations
- memorization aids
- activities for SI sessions
- ethical uses of generative artificial intelligence for tutoring
- successful asynchronous sessions

Submit your Presentation Proposal Submission Planner (in this packet or downloaded from the website) to your local program leadership, who are responsible to electronically submit vetted proposals to the conference organizers.
